School transport services

Your child has been granted school transport, and this leaflet contains information for guardians. For more information on school transport services, eligible distances or the decision-making process, read more at www.vaxjo.se/skolskjuts

Allocation of responsibilities

Parents are responsible for pupils until they have boarded the school vehicle at the designated pick-up point, and after they have disembarked at the designated drop-off point at the end of the school day.

The transporter, through the driver, is responsible for the pupils while they are traveling to and from school and for compliance with applicable traffic regulations. In the event of incident or abuse in connection with school transport, the head teacher is responsible for investigating it.

Safety

Pupils using school transport will have regular reviews of rules and safety measures along with evacuation drills. Pupils must embark and disembark the vehicle in an orderly fashion. Pupils must remain seated while traveling. Seat belts must be used.

Rules

Pupils must remain in their seats during the journey and wait until the bus has stopped before getting off.

Pupils who need to cross a road after disembarking must wait until the vehicle has left. Pupils must pay attention to and follow the driver's instructions. The driver will report any breaches of these rules to traffic control.

Anyone cycling to the pick-up point must park their bicycle where it does not hinder pedestrians/traffic.

Claims for compensation may be made against anyone causing damage to school transport vehicles. All vandalism is reported to the police.

Delayed or cancelled school transport in the morning

If a school transport vehicle is not available at the agreed departure time, you can contact the company that takes the pupil to school.

As a general rule, if a school transport vehicle is delayed by more than 30 minutes, pupils will return home or to another place indicated by their parents.

Delayed or cancelled school transport in the afternoon

Pupils contact school staff who in turn contact the county transport service/school transport officer. The pupil must stay at the school until the replacement vehicle has arrived.

Bringing friends on school transport

If your child wishes to bring a friend on their school transport, this is handled by their school. Contact the school staff for more information.
