Special school transport

Your child has been granted school transport, and this leaflet contains information for you as a guardian. For more information on school transport services, eligible distances or the decision-making process, read more: www.vaxjo.se/skolskjuts

Eligible students are offered special school transport to and from the following special compulsory schools: Kungsmadskolan, Ljungfälleskolan, Hagavik, Högstorp and Östra Lugnet, as well as from the following resource units: Sofieberg and Pär Lagerkvistskolan.

Special school transport should not be considered as single taxi journeys but as a number of fixed routes with a timetable that indicates approximate departure times. The routes usually start at the far end of the municipality, heading towards central Växjö in the morning, and in the opposite direction of travel at the end of the school day. The departure times to school are adapted to the teaching so that pupils arrive at school each day in good time before the start of classes. Trips home usually depart about ten minutes after the end of the school day.

Allocation of responsibilities

Parents are responsible for pupils until they have boarded the school vehicle at the designated pick-up point, and after they have disembarked at the designated drop-off point at the end of the school day. The transporter, through the driver, is responsible for the pupils while they are traveling to and from school and for compliance with applicable traffic regulations.

In the event of incident or abuse in connection with school transport, the head teacher is responsible for investigating it.

Safety

Pupils must embark and disembark the vehicle in an orderly fashion. Pupils must remain seated while traveling. Seat belts must be used.

What is special school transport?

Special school transport is the daily transportation of pupils between their home and their special compulsory school or resource unit. School transport is mainly provided through procurement of school transport vehicles. Under certain circumstances, school transport may instead be offered in the form of public transport.
